Jerry began having heart trouble 20 years ago...quadruple bypass was performed and he was doing well until 2011, when he began experiencing congestive heart failure. A defibrillator and pacemaker was inserted. A few months later, he was admitted back into the hospital for failing circulation in his leg. At that time his kidneys began to fail, the leads from his defibrillator had come loose and needed repair, and, a toe would need to be amputated. It took two weeks for the doctors to stabilize him for the beginning of several surgeries.

A year has passed, and those surgeries are behind him, however, another procedure on his leg will be done the Tuesday after the Bright Light Gala. Doctors are in "SAVE The LEG" mode and everyone's prayers are greatly appreciated. Jerry is totally disabled now and has less than half a heart working and three valves are working with 30 to 40% usage.
